

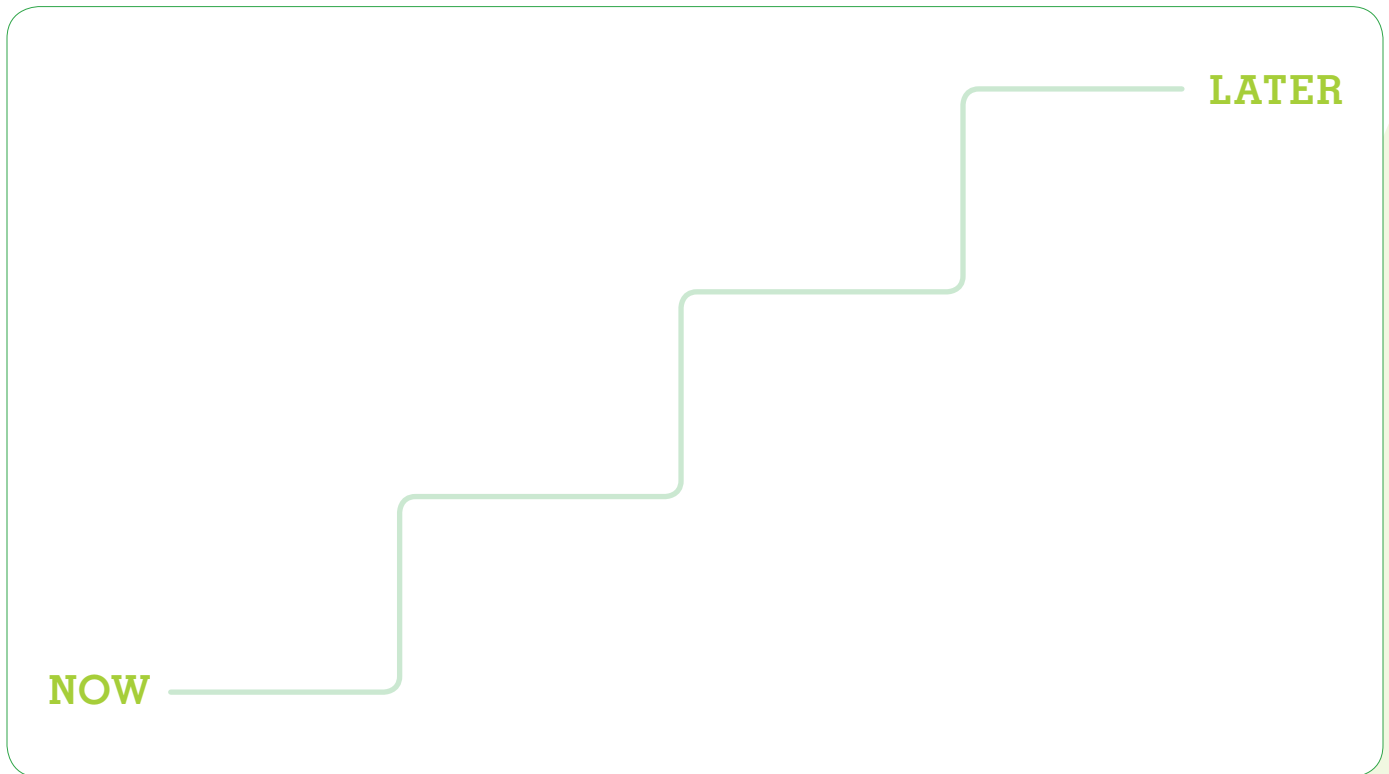


Goal
