My Students

The curriculum is engaging for students because it includes real-world examples and media-rich activities that emphasize skill building, critical thinking, ethical discussion, media creation, and decision making. It also is aligned to standards for English Language Arts, so I can meet state standards at the same time. The curriculum is available in an interactive and multi-touch iBooks Textbooks format, so students get to learn and practice their digital citizenship skills using the devices they engage in everyday.

The iBooks Textbooks from Common Sense also include materials that I can share with my students' families, so that they can learn about digital citizenship too and reinforce learning at home. There are also training materials, which will help me learn how to most effectively implement the curriculum with my students.

Using this curriculum will help all my students learn how to be good digital citizens, and allow them to harness technology for learning and life!
